Get there the easy way on the bus! Nearly one in every five State Fair visitors takes the bus to save on gas and avoid the frustration of traffic and parking. Plus, it's better for the environment!

Special express service is available from sites all over the metro. A round trip costs just \$5 and the bus picks you up right where it drops you off across Como Avenue from [Gate 9](#).

Regular [Route 960](#) travels on Nicollet Mall in downtown Minneapolis and goes directly to the fair in about 15 minutes. [Route 3](#) (Como) and [84](#) (Snelling) also serve the Fairgrounds.
