

Route 22

Route Information:

Route 22 has four branches north of 45th/Bryant Ave. All off-peak trips will serve the Brooklyn Center Transit Center. The "A" branch travels on Bryant Ave., Dupont Ave. and 57th Ave. The "B" branch travels via Humboldt Ave. and Logan Ave. The current Route 5 "R" branch on 49th and 51st Ave. will be served by Route 22 instead. The northern terminal for the peak-only "C" branch is 69th Ave./Humboldt Ave.; Route 22C buses travel via 69th Ave. and Dupont Ave.

Portions of the route north of I-94 will be served by Route 722 instead.

Route 22 will be extended to serve Cedar Ave. and the V.A. Hospital in south Minneapolis (current Route 19).
