What is the C Line?



- Rapid Bus!
 - Limited stops
 - Frequent
 - Off-board payment
 - Articulated buses
 - Enhanced waiting areas
- A package of improvements that makes service faster and more comfortable
- Second in series of rapid bus lines starting with the A Line

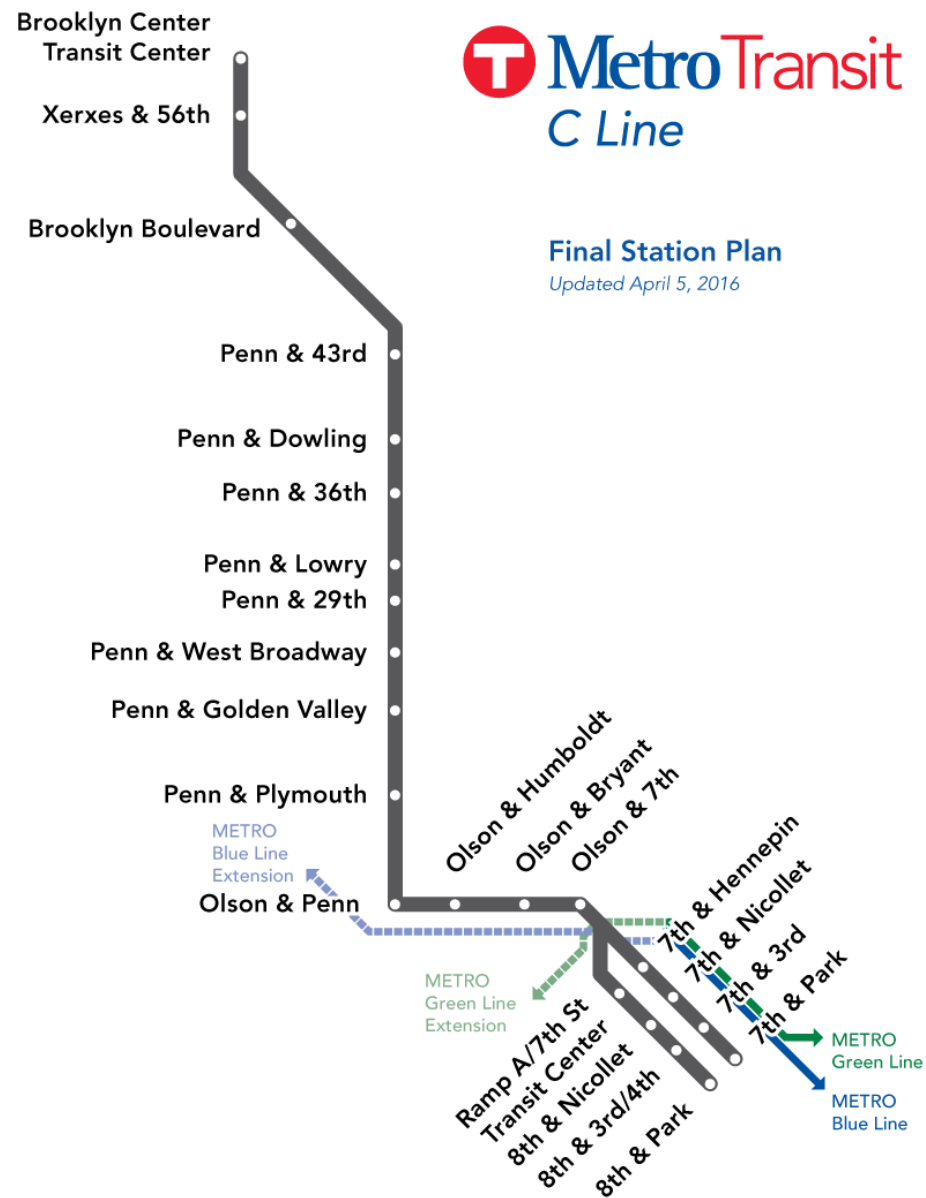

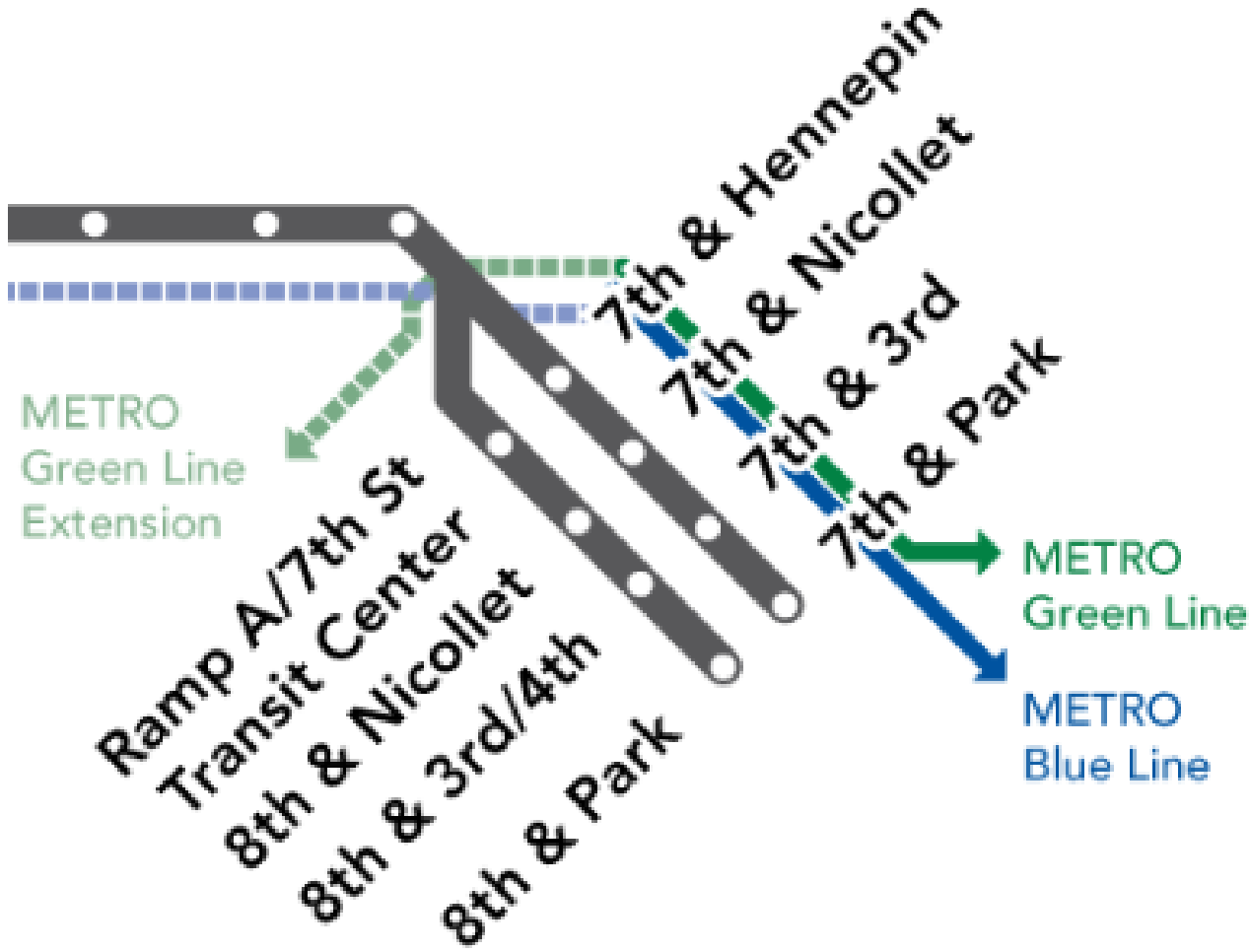
Route 19

- **Outreach and engagement**
 - Open houses
 - Neighborhood meetings
 - Transit rider outreach on buses and at stops
- **Agency coordination**
 - Hennepin County
 - City of Minneapolis
 - City of Brooklyn Center
 - Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board
 - Three Rivers Park District

- Finalized by Metropolitan Council Spring 2016
- C Line will open on Olson Highway with temporary stations, but Olson/Glenwood process will determine long-term alignment by end of 2016



Downtown Stations



- City of Minneapolis plans to reconstruct 8th Street from Hennepin Avenue to Chicago Avenue in 2019-2020
- Temporary operations prior to reconstruction; permanent stations built after reconstruction
- Street configuration, station design/location will be finalized in 8th Street Reconstruction final design and engineering

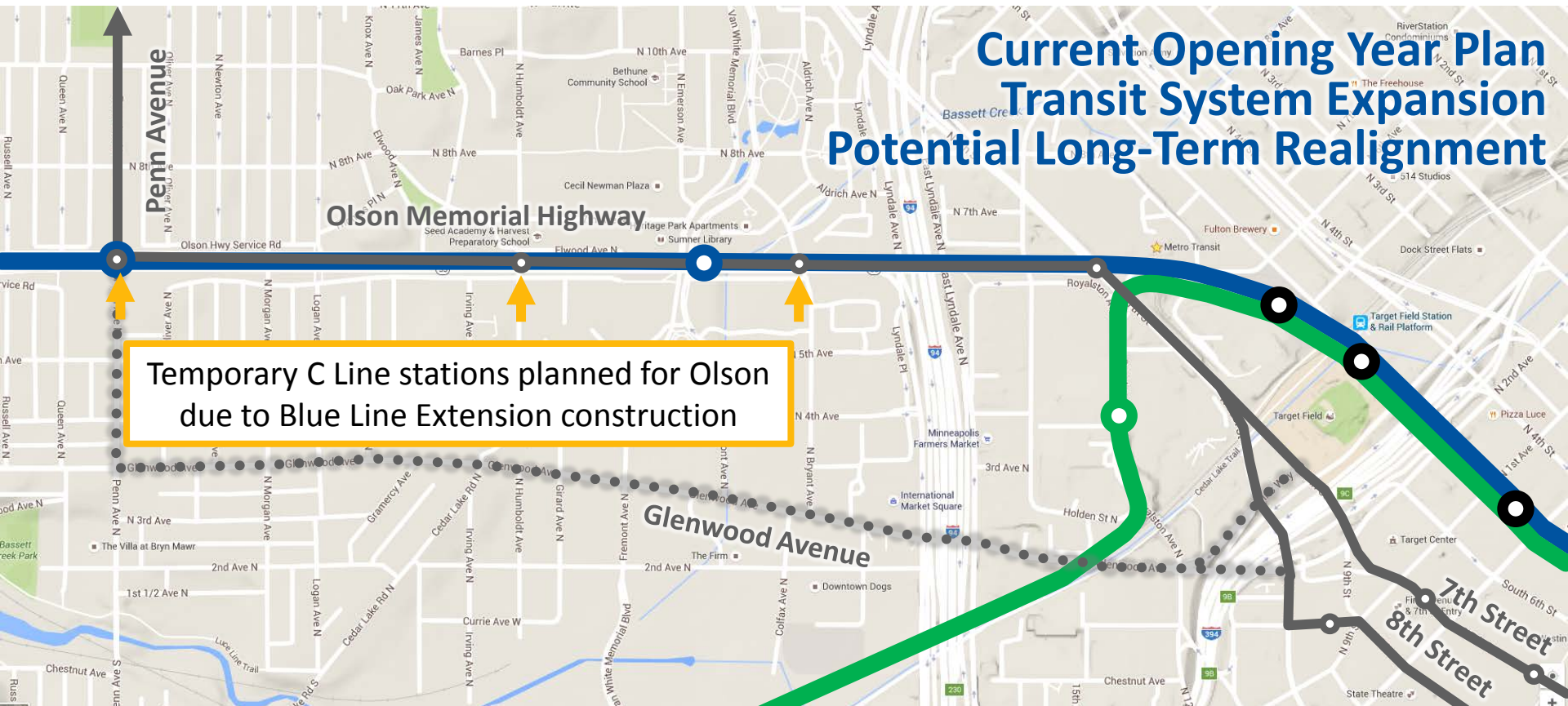
Revised C Line project timeline

- Shift construction from 2017 to 2018
 - Full funding not identified for 2017
 - Initiate design mid-2016; 12-18 months of plan preparation
 - Potential for better coordination with other corridor construction projects
