





METRO F Line Bus Rapid Transit

- Faster, frequent, all-day service
- 13-mile corridor from downtown Minneapolis to Northtown **Transit Center**
 - Downtown alignment: Nicollet Mall, Washington Ave, 3rd Ave
- Substantial upgrade to Route 10
 - F Line will be the primary service on Central Ave in Minneapolis
- Improved speed and reliability
- Serve all-day, all-purpose trips
- Planned 32 stations with enhanced features
 - 7 downtown: 6 existing on Nicollet Mall, 1 new at 3rd Ave & 2nd St
- Targeted opening in 2026

Arterial BRT: Designed to be faster, more reliable, and easy to use



2-3 stations per mile for faster trips



High-tech, high-amenity, secure stations



Bus priority signals & lanes



Pre-boarding fare payment for faster stops




Faster, frequent, all-day service

- Concept bus service plan
- Priorities for bus priority treatments to meet speed and reliability goals
- Project history and planning process to date




Station Locations: Nicollet Mall

- F Line will serve 6 stations along Nicollet
 Mall served today by Route 10
- Use existing enhanced bus stops added with 2017 redesign of Nicollet Mall
- F Line project will add fare collection equipment and signage
- Route transfer opportunities at cross streets
- Many downtown destinations



Station Locations: 3rd Ave & 2nd St

- New station, using some existing facilities
- Station location considerations
 - Pedestrian safety and environment
 - Land use and access to destinations
 - Spacing between stations
 - Existing ridership
 - Connecting transit service
 - Community input
 - Speed and reliability
 - Street design and available right-of-way



3rd Ave S & 2nd St S

- NB platform locations is existing Route 10 bus stop
- SB platform location not an existing bus stop
- Curb extensions ("bump outs") at platforms to reduce crossing distances, provide space for amenities, and improve speed and reliability
- Platforms will safely incorporate bikeways (sidewalk level), pedestrians, and transit users
- Coordination with MnDOT, City, County








3rd Ave S & 2nd St S - Northbound platform

- New shelter not anticipated
- Use existing integrated waiting area for shelter, light and heat
- Curb extension and lack of free-standing shelter provide additional space
- Continuous sidewalk level protected bike lane
