

Route 9

Route Information

Route 9 west of downtown will be simplified. The six branches will be reduced to three. Due to low ridership, service will be discontinued on:

- Cedar Lake Road between Glenwood and Penn Avenues
- Cedar Lake Parkway, Cedar Lake Road, Ewing Avenue, and France Avenue (Route 9H)
- Cedar Lake Road between Highway 100 and Park Place Boulevard
- Zarthan Avenue between Cedar Lake Road and 16th Street

Riders on the Route 9D between Louisiana Transit Center and Park Place & Wayzata will be served by the new Route 645.

Riders on Glenwood Avenue west of Penn and on Xenia Avenue will have two peak period trips on the Route 9B that will operate as a demonstration service.

Riders on the Route 9H on Barry Street and 26th Street will be served by an extension of the Route 25.

Route 9 will be rerouted via 16th Street and Utica Ave to better serve the West End.







Frequency
