

Commuter Rail Transit Village Parking Ramp and Pedestrian Overpass Construction

In early May, 2013, the City of Anoka will commence construction of a 3-level, 344 space parking ramp and pedestrian overpass crossing of the BNSF tracks at the Anoka Northstar Station. The City has selected Sheehy Construction Company to perform the work. The new parking ramp and overpass are planned to be open for use by Northstar patrons in December 2013.

The parking ramp will be located immediately south of the BNSF tracks and will serve as a multi-modal transit hub providing bus, vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle access to the station platforms. The pedestrian overpass will be similar to those located at the Ramsey and Coon Rapids Stations. The parking ramp has been a part of the long-term plan for the Anoka Station since the initial design of the Northstar Commuter Rail Project. The primary objectives of the project are as follows:

- Improve safety for Northstar patrons
- Make Northstar more convenient for users by providing covered parking close to the station platform
- Provide consolidated transit access and service
- Make land that is currently used for surface parking available for development

The Anoka Northstar Station will remain open during the construction of the parking ramp and overpass. Parking for Northstar patrons will be available in the current north lot and in a temporary parking lot east of 4th Avenue and north of Johnson Street. The existing south parking lot will be closed to allow for the construction of the parking ramp.

The project is being funded through a combination of federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds, Counties Transit Improvement Board (CTIB) funds, Anoka County Regional Railroad Authority (ACRRA) funds, and City of Anoka funds. The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) and the Metropolitan Council are also involved in the development of the project. The project has been made possible only through the partnership and cooperation of these agencies.

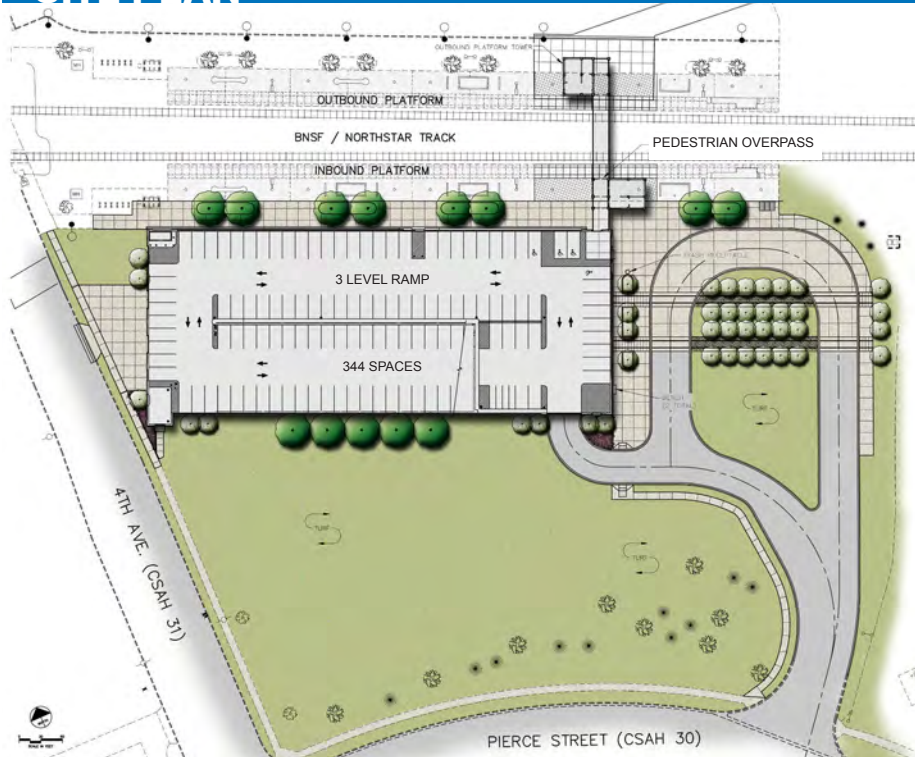
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SITE PLAN
