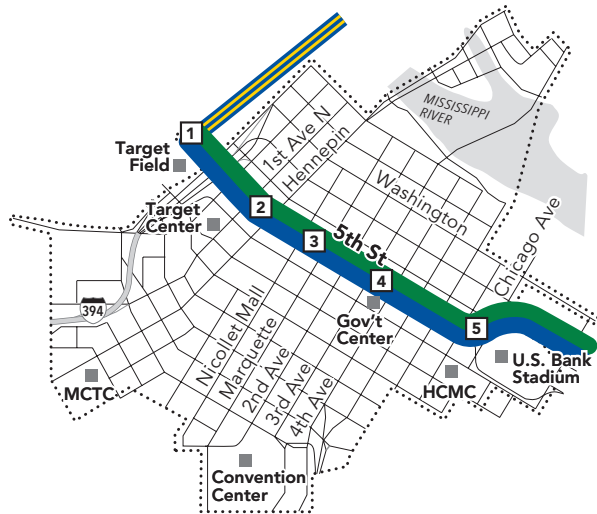


Minneapolis Downtown Zone

Ride in the Downtown Zone for 50¢

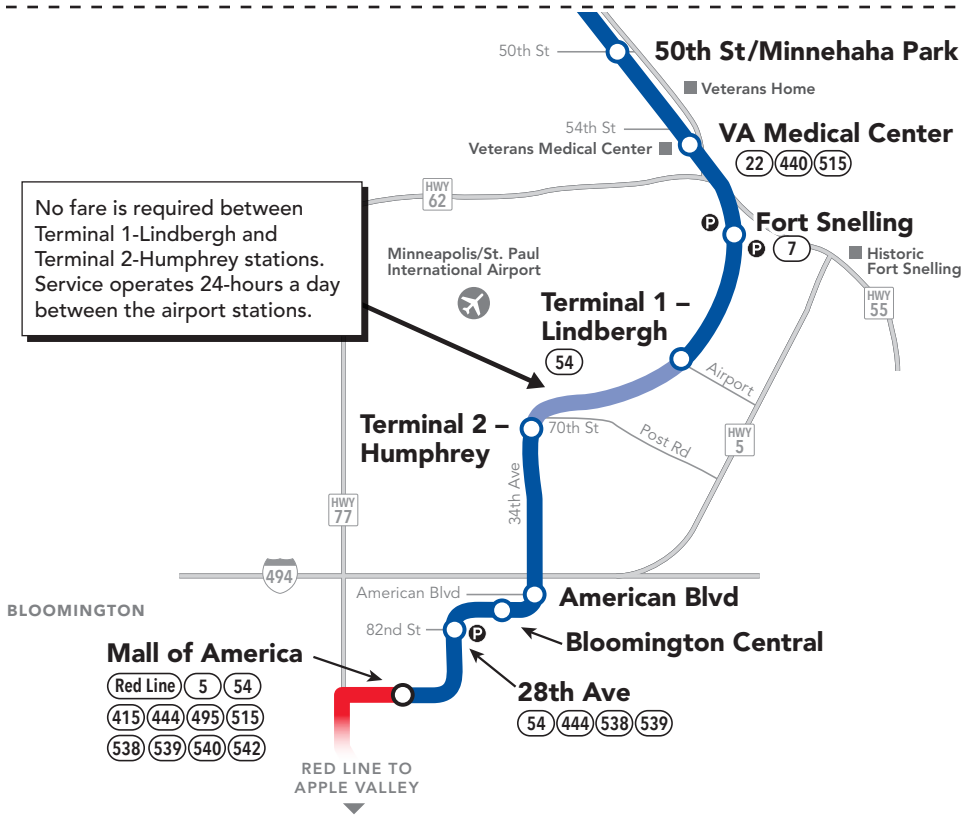

No fare is required between Terminal 1-Lindbergh and Terminal 2-Humphrey stations. Service operates 24-hours a day between the airport stations.
