Good news for commuter benefits!

Congress has continued the \$230 monthly pre-tax commuter transit benefit allowance through 2011. This amount was set to revert back to \$120 effective Jan. 1.

Internal Revenue Code Section 132(f) allows employees the choice to direct a portion of their salary into reimbursement accounts to pay for certain work-related parking and/or transit expenses on a pre-tax basis. There are two separate accounts -- one for transit expenses and another for parking expenses.

By deferring money into these accounts, an employee can save an average of 40 percent by using pre-tax dollars to pay for commuting expenses. Employers also benefit as they can save an average of up to 10 percent in payroll tax savings.

When IRC Section 132 was originally written, the monthly transit pre-tax allowance was \$120. Under the American Resource Recovery Act, the pre-tax payroll deduction limit for transit was increased to \$230 on March 1, 2009, while maintaining the \$230 monthly limit for parking expenses.

Enhanced privacy and security settings


- You decide on how much account information is shared with potential car- or vanpool partners.
