

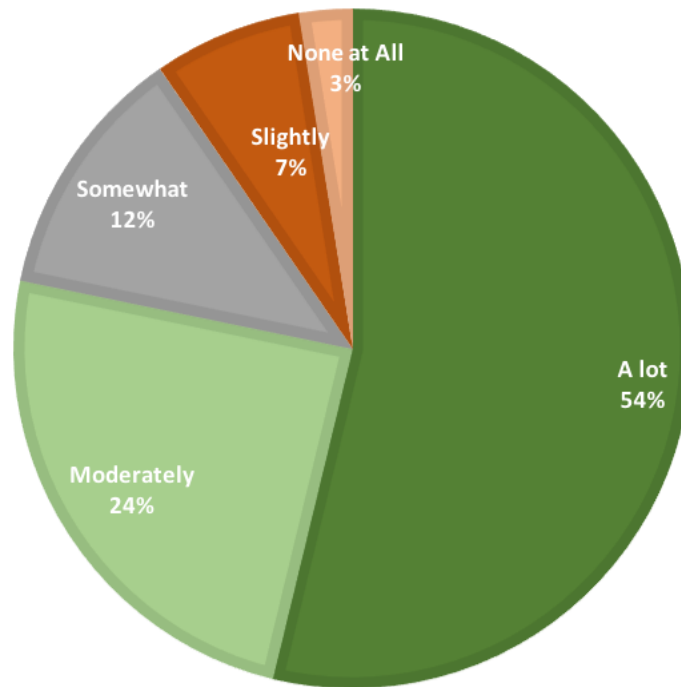

How much do you enjoy public art?

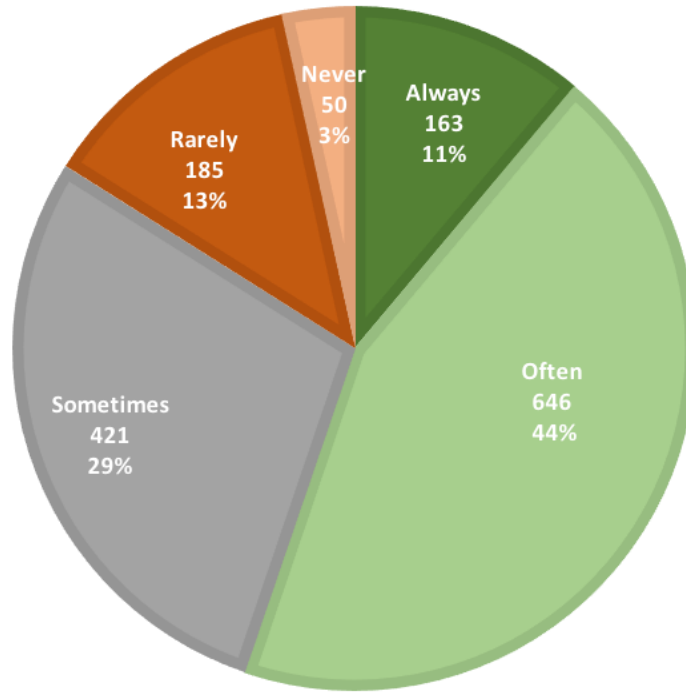
■ A lot ■ Moderately ■ Somewhat ■ Slightly ■ None at All

How often do you stop to look at public art?

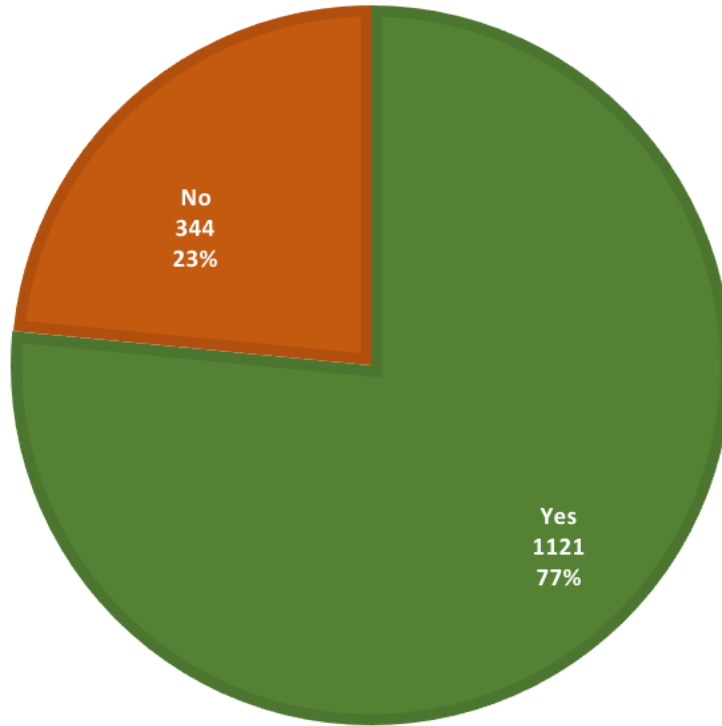
■ Always ■ Often ■ Sometimes ■ Rarely ■ Never

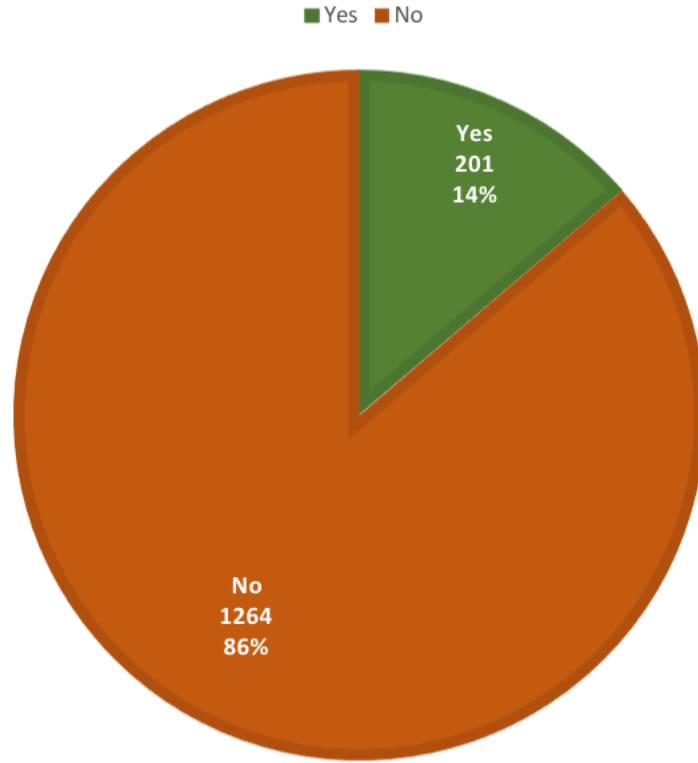
Have you noticed the public art at the LRT stations?

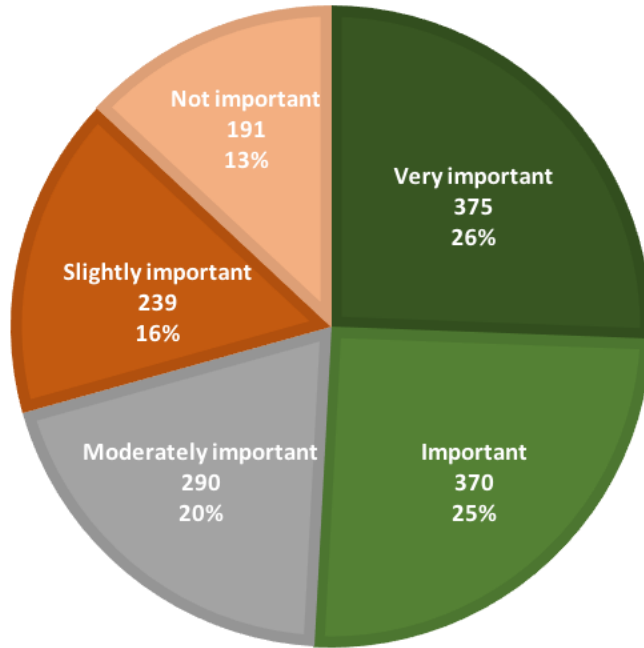
Did you know that Metro Transit has more than 70 pieces in its public art collection?

How important is Metro Transit public are to your overall experience riding transit?

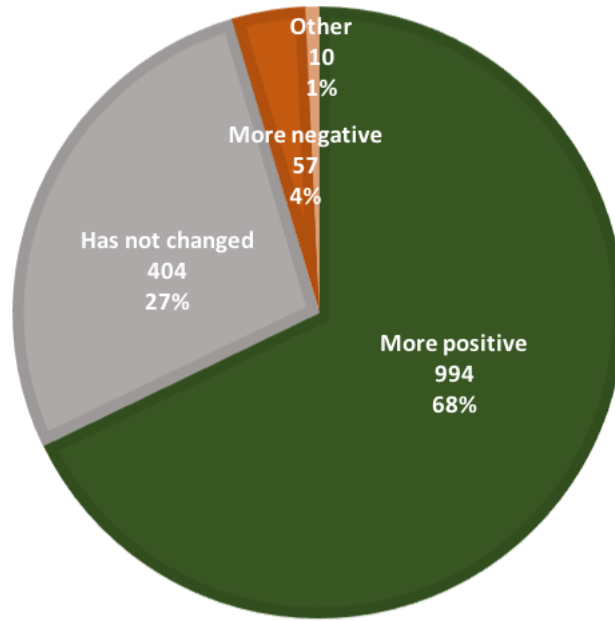

How does having a public art collection affect your impression of Metro Transit?

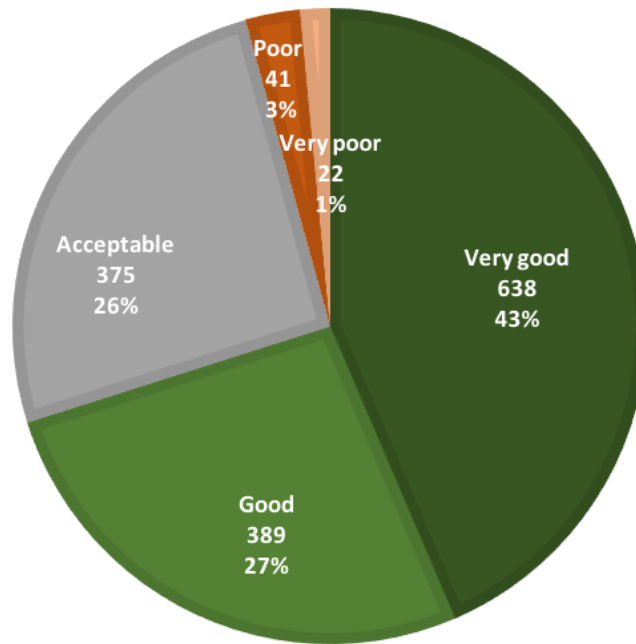

How would you rate the quality of the public art: is it well constructed, well maintained, interesting to look at and speaking to the human experience?

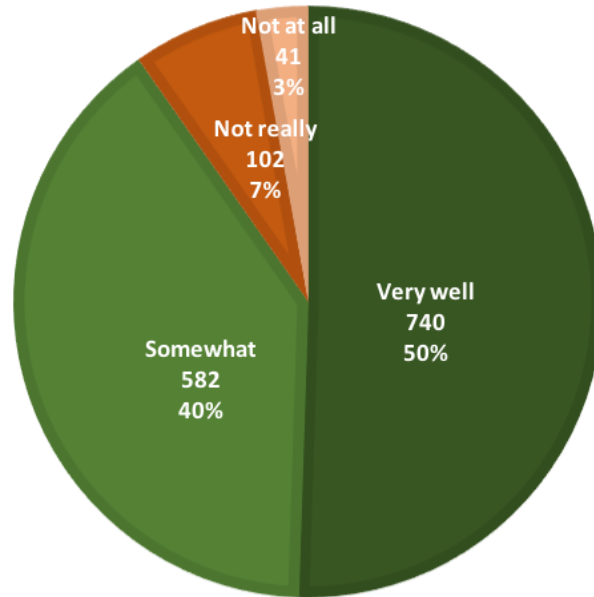

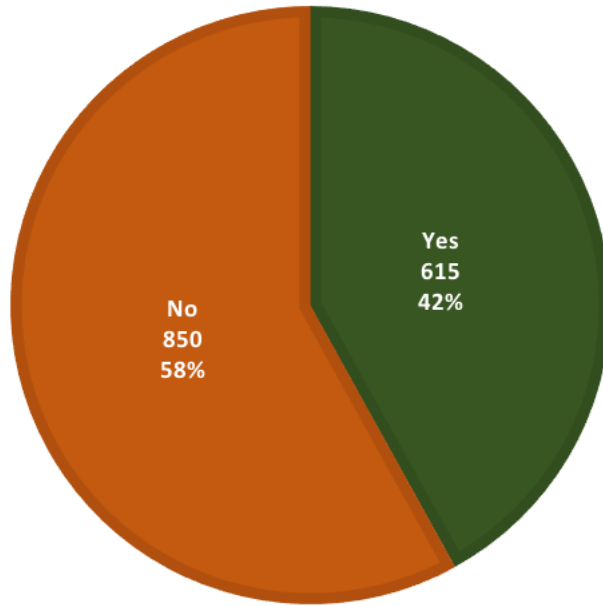
