

# TRANSIT GUIDE FOR ST. PAUL VISITORS







## POPULAR DESTINATIONS IN / AROUND ST. PAUL

#### DOWNTOWN MINNEAPOLIS

By train: board the Green Line at any METRO Station. By bus: board Route 94 on 6th St.

#### MALL OF AMERICA

A shopper's paradise, with more than 500 stores. By bus: take Route 54 – board on 6th St. By train: take the Green Line toward Minneapolis. At U.S. Bank Stadium Station, transfer to the Blue Line to Mall of America Station.

#### MINNESOTA CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Features educational, entertaining exhibits on different aspects of our world. By bus: take any 6th St. route. By train: take the Green Line, get off at 10th St. Station.

#### MINNESOTA HISTORY CENTER

Features exhibits and multimedia presentations that explore Minnesota's past. By bus: take Route 21 – board on 6th St.

#### MSP INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Blue Line serves Terminal 1 – Lindbergh and Terminal 2 – Humphrey. By bus: take Route 54 – board on 6th St. By train: take the Green Line toward Minneapolis. At U.S. Bank Stadium Station, transfer to the Blue Line to Mall of America. Get off at Terminal 1 or Terminal 2 Station.

#### RIVERCENTRE

This state-of-the-art facility hosts many shows that are open to the public. By bus: take Route 54 or 74A – board on 6th St.

#### SCIENCE MUSEUM OF MINNESOTA

Features displays of fossils and dinosaurs, plus interactive exhibits and demonstrations. It's also home to the Omnitheater. By bus: take any 6th St. route.

#### STATE CAPITOL

This stunning historic site offers hourly guided tours. By train: take the Green Line toward Minneapolis to Capitol/Rice Street Station.

#### THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. PAUL

Impressive dome, classical Renaissance style. By bus: take Route 21 – board on 6th St.

#### XCEL ENERGY CENTER

Home of Minnesota Wild hockey, concerts and events. By bus: take Route 54 or 74A – board on 6th St.

#### UNION DEPOT

A multimodal transportation hub and event venue. By bus: take Route 21, 54 or 94D – board on 5th St. By train: take the Green Line toward St. Paul, get off at Union Depot Station. Connect to Amtrak trains, Greyhound and Jefferson bus lines.

#### Online

# CONNECTING FROM THE AIRPORT

There is no bus service from Terminal 2. Take the Blue Line to Terminal 1 and follow the directions below.

#### Bus service to downtown St. Paul:

From the Terminal 1 ground transportation area, follow signs for the Gold Ramp. Go up two levels to the waiting area. The bus stop is located across the pedestrian crossing from the building (look for the bus shelter). Route 54 service operates roughly every 15 minutes. Travel time is 20 minutes.



#### **FARES**

Fares range from \$0.50 to \$3.25 depending on time of travel and type of service.

On METRO lines, buy a ticket from machines at stations. Tickets are valid for bus and METRO lines rides for 2½ hours. Credit cards are accepted and change is available. Keep your ticket as proof of fare payment for police officers who patrol trains.

On buses, place dollar bills or coins in the farebox. Sorry, change is not available. To transfer to another bus or train, ask for a transfer, which is valid for bus and METRO Line rides for 2½ hours.

Or, download the free Metro Transit app to buy tickets right from your phone!

#### **FARE OPTIONS**

These fares help you explore more for less! All fares subject to change.

**Downtown Zone** – Only 50¢ at any time ride within the St. Paul Downtown Zone. (Transfers are not available.)

#### All-Day Pass - Starting at \$4

Unlimited rides on all buses and METRO lines from time of purchase until 2 a.m. the next day. Available only at METRO ticket machines or on Metro Transit's app.

#### 24-Hour Pass - \$6.50

Get unlimited rides on buses and METRO lightrail for a full 24 hours. Passes can be purchased from a rail ticket machine or through the Metro Transit app. Visit metrotransit.org/app for details.

#### Visitor Pass - \$5

Unlimited rides until 2 a.m. after first use. Available online or at a Metro Transit service center only.
