Statement of Sergeant T. Lawrence 72413

I was in full MTPD uniform and a fully marked squad car when I was dispatched to a DOC female on a Route 39 holding at 8th and Hennepin.

I arrived and spoke to the bus operator later identified as [REDACTED] dob: [REDACTED] she was run through dispatch and clear. I asked [REDACTED] what was going on and [REDACTED] stated the following in summary. [REDACTED] stated that the passenger later identified as CHANDLER Kenya Patrice dob: [REDACTED] she was run through dispatch and clear. CHANDLER boarded the bus and she was mad the [REDACTED] did not stop where she wanted to stop and CHANDLER stated that "You are just a stupid white bitch". At this point [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did not feel safe to proceed and [REDACTED] call for police to remove CHANDLER. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] would sign a citizens arrest form for CHANDLER'S actions. There were only two people on the bus and [REDACTED] pointed to CHANDLER stating that she was the female and she wanted her off of [REDACTED] bus.

I made contact with CHANDLER and ask her to exit the bus so we could talk about what had happened and she refused. Stating that she did not say anything to the driver. I then gave CHANDLER a second command to exit the bus and then sometime to make her decision. I told CHANDLER a third time that she needed to exit the bus and she stated something to the effect of "What are you going to handcuff me" I told her I did not want to have to go that route and that I just want to have a conversation with her outside of the bus. Chandler then stood up and walked to the rear of the bus and this is when I felt that CHANDLER was going to try to fight me so I requested backup. Chandler was at the rear of the bus and I followed her. Chandler was saying something but I could not hear what was said. Chandler then started to walk to the front of the bus and I stood in her way and told her she needed to exit the rear door. CHANDLER stated that she wanted to exit the front door and I told her "No" I did this for the safety of [REDACTED] the bus operator because CHANDLER was still yelling at [REDACTED]. CHANDLER then was at the back door and yelled to [REDACTED] "I Did call you a stupid white bitch!!" and then exited the bus.

As we were standing outside of the bus I tried to explain to CHANDLER that she just needed to calm down and ride a different bus. CHANDLER started yelling and making a scene. Due to her behavior I asked for CHANDLER'S identification. CHANDLER started to dig into her purse and then pulled out her MN DL. I asked CHANDLER to hand it to me and she refused. I could tell that CHANDLER was getting more aggressive because she was grabbing her bag and pulling it close to her and it seemed like she was getting ready to try and fight me. I asked for my backup to step it up. I asked CHANDLER for her ID again and tried to grab it but she pulled it away. At this point there were other people starting to gather and yelling at me and I felt that I needed to secure CHANDLER before anything bad would happen and I grabbed CHANDLER'S left wrist and told her she was being detained and turned her around and tried to pin her against the bus shelter. I was able to get her left hand behind her back but could not get her right one. At this point CHANDLER started to scream for help and the crowd grew even more and they were becoming hostile. I called dispatch and stated that it has become a help call and need squads immediately. I had CHANDLER pinned against the bus shelter telling her to put her hands behind her back and she stated she could not so I let her off of the bus shelter so she could put her arm behind her back. When I did this she tried to free her left arm. I then put CHANDLER in an arm lock to her left arm and just stood there waiting for my backup. The crowd continued to yell at me and were very hostile. An unidentified male approached me stating he was CHANDLER'S husband and wanted to know what was going on and I told him once the scene was secure that I would explain everything to him. I told him to back away from me and he complied. Officer A. Olson arrived on scene and I told her that we needed to get CHANDLER handcuffed. I then gave commands to CHANDLER to get on the ground. CHANDLER still

would not comply so I did an arm bar take down and CHANDLER ended up on her stomach and Myself and Officer A. Olson were able to get her handcuffed. Officers immediately turned CHANDLER onto her back. Officer A. Olson then assisted her to her feet and walked her to her squad car. Officer A. Olson searched CHANDLER search incident to arrest and then placed CHANDLER in the rear of her squad car. I told Officer A. Olson to transport CHANDLER to the 7th Street garage to get her out of the area because the crowd was still large and hostile.

I then spoke to the unidentified male who did not want to be identified but stated that he was CHANDLER's husband. I explained to him what had happened and I gave him my business card with the case number on it and told him to call with any questions.

I then went to the 7th Street garage and spoke with Officer A. Olson and told her to book CHANDLER for DOC 609.72.1.

I went to the [REDACTED] Garage and spoke to [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] was on break. I asked if [REDACTED] needed peer support or medical attention and [REDACTED] refused. I then gave [REDACTED] a citizens arrest form and [REDACTED] filled it out. I submitted the Citizens arrest form with the rest of the paperwork at West Command to attached to this case. While [REDACTED] was filling out the form I could see that [REDACTED] was still upset about the incident. [REDACTED] was shaking and stated that "What am I supposed to do, She (CHANDLER) is a regular and I feel that next time she is going to attack me" I told [REDACTED] to be courteous and if [REDACTED] has any issues to call the police again.
