# WHAT WE DO

We are committed to the personal safety, quality of life, & protection of property for everyone in our transit community. Our agency oversees one of the country's largest transit systems. Officers respond to & investigate all crimes reported on buses, light rail, commuter trains, facilities, & right-ofways.

We are fully-sworn peace officers with the same powers of arrest as other city or county law enforcement agencies. Our officers can take enforcement action off Metro Transit property for traffic violations, petty offenses, or any other criminal act. We will take the necessary steps to control a scene, then defer the case to the local agency.

## OUR METHODS



We believe in proactive policing & community engagement. We use analyzed data & trends to deploy personnel to critical locations throughout the system. We will never criminalize homelessness or individuals suffering from chemical dependency.

Our **Homeless Action Team** (HAT) connects people with food, clothing, medical, & social services. This nationally renowned program has helped 500+ adults & children find more permanent housing since it's launch in 2018.



#### **SPECIALIZED UNITS**

We have **10** specialized units, which include K9, Crash Scene Reconstruction Unit, & SWAT/Counter Threat Unit.



#### **SECURITY CAMERAS**

We have **3,125+** live security cameras across the system – including on buses & light rail trains, & at stations, shelters, & transit centers.
