The METRO Blue Line's Franklin Avenue Station, opened in 2004, is undergoing a major renovation to address aging infrastructure, frequent elevator outages, worn components, and community safety concerns.

The Franklin Avenue Station Renovation project aims to modernize the station, enhancing its service to the community through improved accessibility, a better customer experience, reduced maintenance, and increased connectivity. The designs will also prioritize the use of durable, energy-efficient materials which will help extend the life of station investments and increase the sustainability of the station.

The project is part of the Renew the Blue system restoration initiative and will help the Blue Line remain a safe, reliable, and affordable transit option for many years to come! Learn more at metrotransit.org/renew-the-blue.
