You go to the State Fair for the food, the animals, the rides and more! Getting to the State Fair on the bus is a fun tradition, too. Instead of driving, park your car for free and take a stressfree, non-stop, air-conditioned ride straight to the fairgrounds.

Take a State Fair Express bus and you'll save on gas and parking costs. Plus, we'll drop you off and pick you up right outside the gates!

Buy your bus tickets early and save!

Save yourself time and money when you buy your State Fair Express bus ticket in advance. Bus Bargain Ticket sales start Aug. 1!

After you buy your Bus Bargain Ticket at metrotransit.org/StateFair, simply print it at home or send it directly to your phone.

Express Bus Service Info and FAQ

- Service starts at 8 a.m. (daily) at all Metro Transit locations and as noted by site for MVTA and SouthWest Transit locations
- Last bus leaves the fair at midnight for Metro Transit and MVTA sites and 11:30 p.m. for SouthWest Transit
- State Fair Express sites are staffed from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

How much does a ride cost?

• \$5 cash fare* per person for a roundtrip ride or use your Bus Bargain Ticket or Metro Transit app ticket

- Kids 4 and under ride free
- Veterans with service connected or "SC" I.D. injuries issued from Dept. of Veterans Affairs ride free
- No Go-To cards, passes or coupons

Note: fareboxes don't provide change

Do I get a return ticket?

For faster boarding, we collect round-trip fares and inspect tickets upfront.

Where do I catch my return bus?

Come back to where you are dropped off at the Transit Hub near West End Market. There will be a sign for your Park & Ride location. Your bus will also show the name of the Park & Ride lot.

Combine light rail with a regular route!

METRO + the A Line

If you live or work in downtown St. Paul, take the METRO Green Line to Snelling Ave. Station. Connect there to an A Line bus for a stress-free ride to the fairgrounds. Catch the A Line at the METRO Blue Line's 46th St. Station in south Minneapolis or anywhere along the route in south Minneapolis and St. Paul.

METRO Blue Line

Take the METRO Blue Line to Warehouse District/Hennepin Ave. Station. Connect there to a Route 960 bus – you'll be at the fairgrounds in no time!

Transfers are free.

Regular Bus Routes

FAST, ECONOMICAL SERVICE RIGHT IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

These routes also serve the State Fairgrounds and you can use cash or a transit pass to pay your fare. All are wheelchair accessible.

Live or work in downtown Minneapolis? Get from downtown to the fairgrounds in about 15 minutes. Board on Hennepin Ave.



Take the A Line, with rapid bus service on Snelling Ave. between 46th St. Station and Rosedale, right to the fairgrounds. Ride the METRO Green Line between the two downtowns and transfer to the A Line or Route 84 at Snelling Ave. Station.



It's an easy ride from downtown Minneapolis or downtown St. Paul to a stop at the fairgrounds on Como Ave.

PARKING AT THE FAIR

Hours: 6 a.m. to midnight daily.

Cars*

Parking in all State Fairgrounds lots is filled on a first-come basis for \$14 per car (\$28 for vehicles with trailers, must fit in a double parking space). Limited accessible parking is available for \$14 to those with a valid disability placard.

Motorcycles*

A secured lot is available for motorcycles on the south side of Como Ave. near the International Institute. Parking in this lot is \$8; in other State Fair lots it is \$14.

Bicycles

People who ride a non-motorized bike to the fair can park in one of three FREE bike corrals:

- Como-Snelling Gate
- Hoyt-Snelling Gate
- Buford-Randall Gate


