

The METRO Red Line is the region's first bus rapid transit corridor. The Red Line connects the cities of Apple Valley and Eagan to Mall of America and Bloomington's South Loop. The Mall of America Transit Station allows customers to continue on the METRO Blue Line to Minneapolis.

The Red Line serves these areas:

- Mall of America/South Loop
- Eagan
- Apple Valley

By the Numbers

- 16 miles long
- 21 minutes from end to end
- 5 stations
- 9,750 live within 1/2 mile of stations
- 22,000 approx. jobs within 1/2 mile of stations
- 14 connecting bus routes
