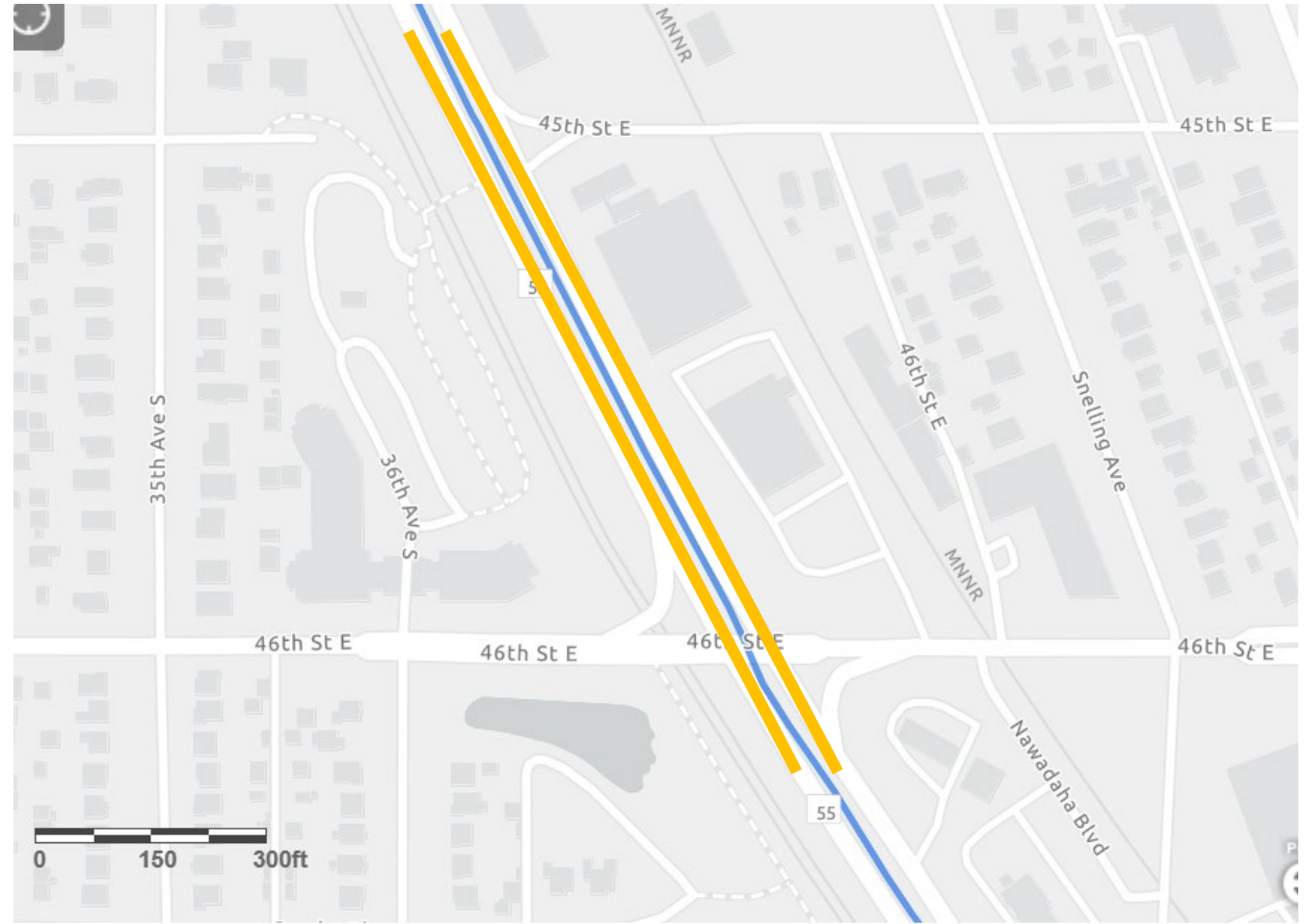

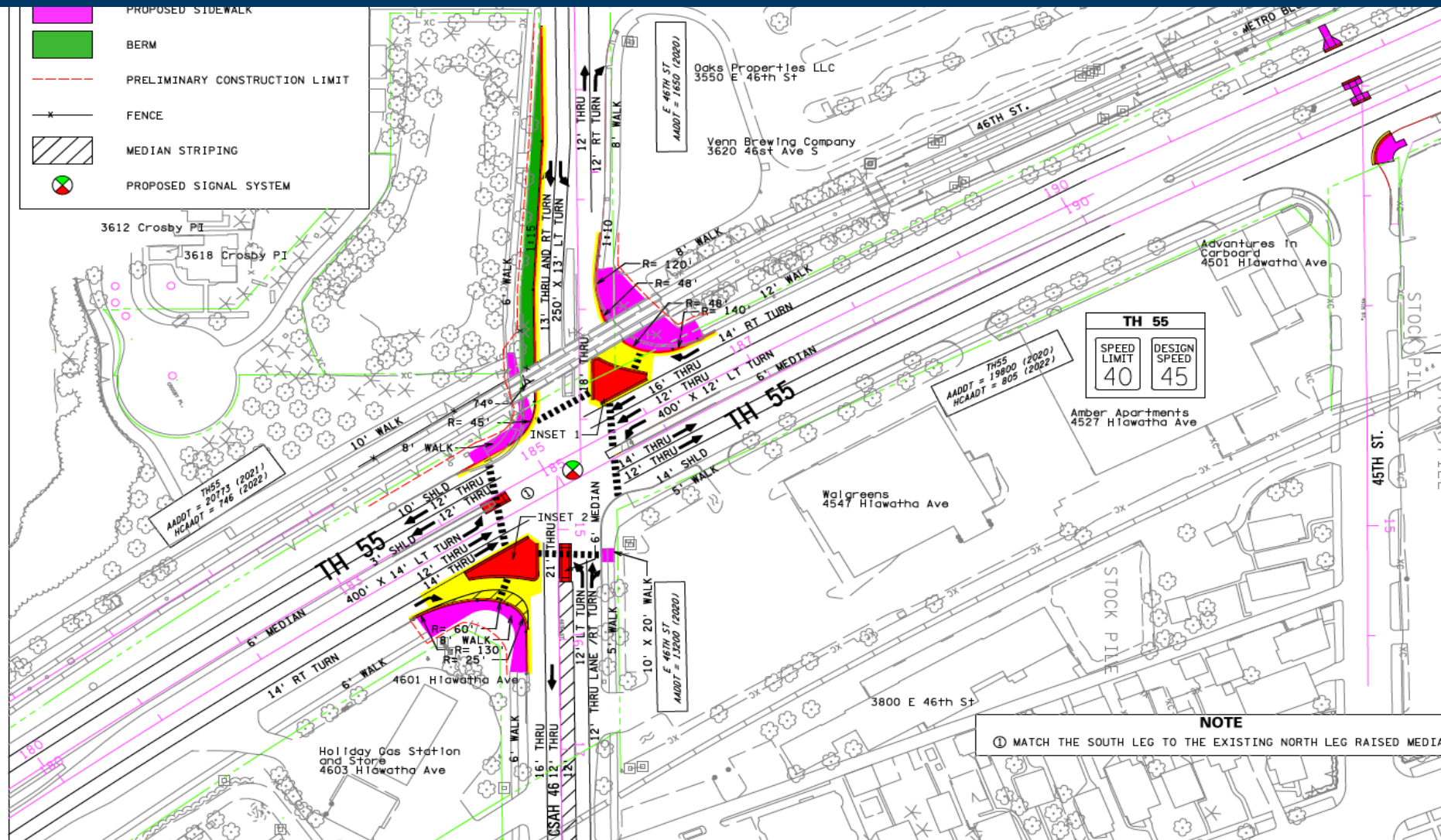

Project Limits

- Construct pedestrian refuge islands
- Reconstruct turn lanes, smart channels on SE and NW corners, for better visibility.
- Realign trail crossing in SW corner.
- Replace the traffic signals
- Add pedestrian signal at 45th St

- Add Pedestrian Signal at 45th St
- Add median fencing between 45th and 46th St

Other Key Improvements

Add Pedestrian Signal to 45th St



- A pedestrian signal will be added to 45th St
- New crosswalks will be added to both the north and south side of 45th St

Other Key Improvements

Add Median Fencing



- Median fencing will be added between 45th and 46th St.
- Prevent midblock pedestrian crossings.
